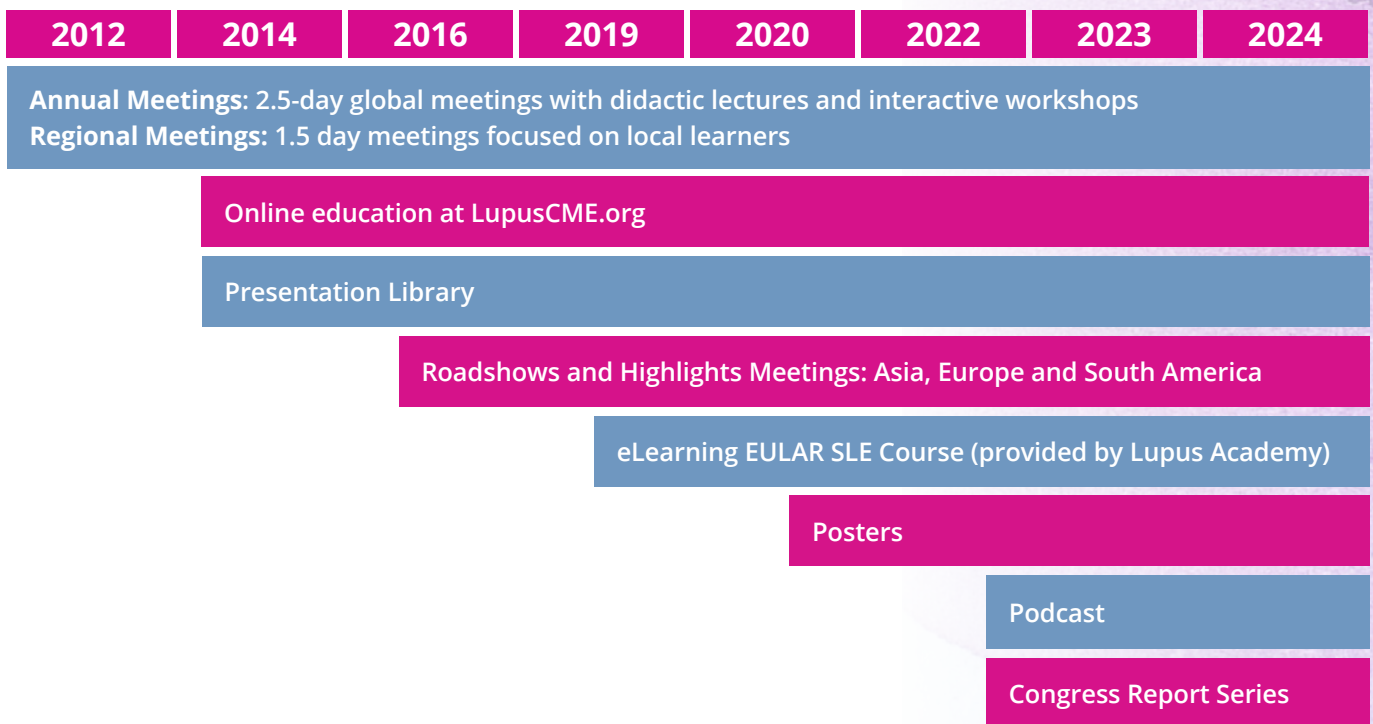
Mission
